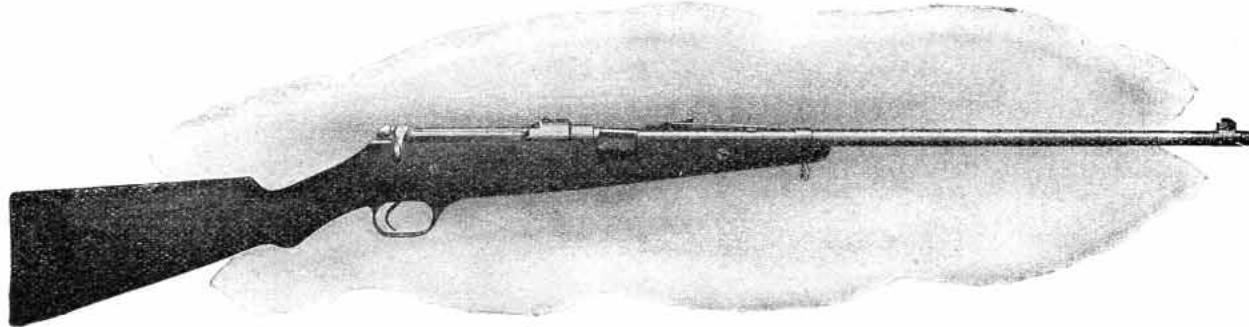




Ross Rifles.

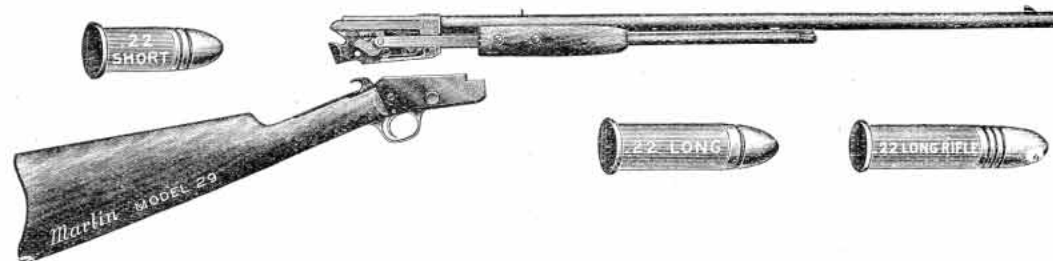


Visible Loading, Handling 22 Short, Long or Long Rifle Cartridges.

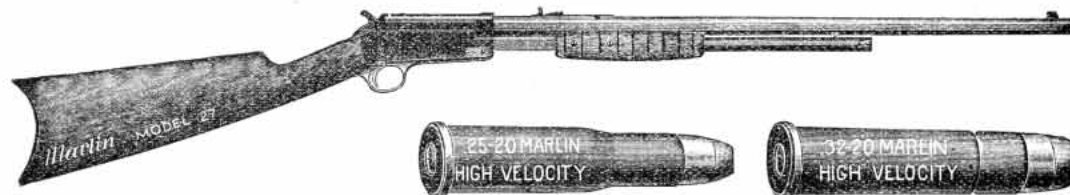

25-20 Calibre, 24 inch smokeless steel barrel, blued frame, blued steel rifle butt plate, black walnut stock and fore end, Rocky Mountain rear and ivory bead front sights, length over all $42\frac{1}{4}$ inches, weight $5\frac{3}{4}$ lbs., each \$18.00
32-20 Calibre, otherwise same as above, " 18.00

The Model 27 is built extra strong throughout on account of the high velocity smokeless loads. The receiver and action parts are all cut from the solid steel drop forgings; the buttstock, fore-arm and all other parts are of first quality material throughout. Note the shapely stock and special rifle buttplate. This gun is guaranteed free from imperfection in material and workmanship. The deep, clean-cut Ballard rifling develops the full range and power, and insures the greatest possible accuracy and a long life for the gun.
